



EBSCOHost Basic Search Quick Start Guide

EBSCOHost allows you to access an extensive collection of academic journals, newspaper and magazine articles full text from your desk top. The EBSCO database collection also offers eBooks, SWOT analyses, images, customizable features and much more.

Access:

The EBSCOHost database collections can be accessed from within the State Library of Ohio and many state agency buildings using the library homepage (www.library.ohio.gov) or remotely using OhioLINK.

From within the State Library of Ohio and many state agency buildings:

- Select "Access OhioLINK Resources" on the library homepage. From there, click "Access OhioLINK resources from a State Library of Ohio location".

Remotely using OhioLINK:

- From the library homepage, select "Access OhioLINK Resources" and then select "Access OhioLINK Resources from Any Other Location".
- Enter your last name and the last nine digits of your State Library of Ohio library card.

Select the "D-E" link under "Databases Listed by Name". Scroll down this page to "EBSCO Databases". After selecting "All EBSCO Databases", you can search individual collections by clicking the title of the collection you wish to search, or browse for a specific title within that collection by clicking the "Title List" link under each collection. View more information about the collection by selecting the "More Information" link. You can also choose to search some or all of the collections together by marking the check boxes next to the collections you wish to search or marking the "Select All" box and clicking the "Continue" button at the top or bottom of the page.

Academic Search Complete
Academic Search Complete is the world's most valuable and comprehensive scholarly, multi-disciplinary full-text database, with more than 7,900 full-text periodicals, including more than 6,800 peer-reviewed journals. In addition to full text, this database offers indexing and abstracts for more than 11,900 journals and a total of more than 12,000 publications including monographs, reports, conference proceedings, etc. The database features PDF content going back as far as 1887, with the majority of full text titles in native (searchable) PDF format. Searchable cited references are provided for more than 1,400 journals.

Academic Search Premier
This multi-disciplinary database provides full text for more than 8,500 journals, including full text for more than 4,600 peer-reviewed titles. PDF backfiles to 1975 or further are available for well over one hundred journals, and searchable cited references are provided for more than 1,000 titles.

Agricola
This database contains bibliographic records from the U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Agricultural Library. Coverage for *AGRICOLA* dates back to 1970 and includes more than 4.8 million citations. The citations are comprised of journal articles, monographs, theses, patents, software, audiovisual materials, and technical reports related to agriculture.

Alt HealthWatch
This database focuses on the many perspectives of complementary, holistic and integrated approaches to health care and wellness. It offers libraries full text articles for more than 180 international, and often peer-reviewed journals and reports. In addition, there are hundreds of pamphlets, booklets, special reports, original research and book excerpts. *Alt HealthWatch* provides in-depth coverage across the full spectrum of subject areas covered by complementary and alternative medicine. This database features indexing and abstracts going back as far as 1984, and full text going back as far as 1990


Bibliography of Native North Americans
Bibliography of Native North Americans (BNNA) is a bibliographic database covering all aspects of native North American culture, history, and life. This resource covers a wide range of topics including archaeology, multicultural relations, gaming, governance, legend, and literacy. BNNA contains more than 137,000 citations for books, essays, journal articles, and government documents of the United States and Canada. Dates of coverage for included content range from the sixteenth century to the present.

Basic Searching on EBSCOhost:

1. Type your search term into the **Find** field.




2. Select a limiter to restrict results to **Full Text**, **Image Quick View** images, **Publication Date**, etc., and click **Search**.



EBSCOhost Results Page:

3. The results list may contain results available in HTML, PDF, or both.



On the result list:

Narrow results by Source Type.

Refine your results with **Search Options** or **Subject Headings**.

Click on available Full Text.

Use the EBSCOhost folder to store articles or to print/email/save multiple results at once.
